MAKING PLANS FOR A SUCCESSFUL GOSPEL MEETING

Plan To Attend Each Service

This is of utmost importance. I cannot stress enough the need for all of usto be present at each of the services. The community will be informed of our meeting in various ways. Some will be visiting from other congregations in the area. Some who are visiting may belong to a denomination in the area. Still others may visit who have never been associated with any religious group. What will they see? Will they see an active body of believers who are striving to do God's will? Will they see a group of Christians who love the Lord with all of their heart, soul, and strength? What will they see? God expects His children to first give themselves to His cause (2 Cor. 8:5). The question is, will you be here? Plan To Bring A Friend With You

Once you have determined to be present during the meeting, it is important to remember the great commission. One way to carry out this command is to invite your friends, neighbors, and family members to hear the gospel preached. Sometimes, even those who are reluctant to come with you, will make exceptions for a special occasion such as a meeting. If possible, get them to ride with you. This serves several purposes: 1. It makes it more difficult for either of you to change your mind about coming, 2. It provides an opportunity for the person to ask questions which he or she might have been reluctant to ask during the meeting, and 3. It provides an opportunity for the non-Christian to get to know you better. I read an article which said that the church has practiced

"accidental evangelism" for too long. Perhaps this is true. We do need to be more straight forward (but not pushy) in our approach if we are to be successful in our evangelism. In Acts 2:47 we read that "the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved. "We often ask why this isn't happening today. The answer lies in the same book in chapter 5:42 "And daily in the temple and in every house, they did not cease teaching and preaching Jesus as the Christ. "It is important for us to remember that God will not do the teaching for us.

Plan To Grow

We often look at a gospel meeting as time for non-Christians to hear the truth and this is true but it is also valuable time for Christians to hear and learn truth and to grow thereby. We must remember that we can never learn too much. And we can always learn something more than we already know. We should therefore plan to grow spiritually from the lessons that are presented. And we can expect to grow proportionately to the amount of effort that we extend. Notice the words of the apostle Paul: "Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord,"(1 Cor. 15:58).
