A VIBRANT JOY AND A VISIBLE HOPE

It is reported that Friedrich Nietzsche, the atheistic philosopher, once stated, "Jesus' disciples will need to look more saved if I am to believe in their Savior."

Whether or not Nietzsche said this, I believe that the statement is true. If we are going to convince the world of the value and validity of Christianity, then we are going to have to have a vibrant joy and a visible hope. To the saints at Rome, Paul wrote, "Rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer" (Romans 12:12).

If we will rejoice in hope, then those around us will ask us for a reason of the hope and joy that is within us. Peter wrote, "But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a

reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear" (1 Peter 3:15).

I am confident that one of the reasons the early church grew so rapidly and reached so many was because of the joy that radiated from them. Their gladness of heart was noted several times by the sacred historian Luke. They received the word and one another with gladness (Acts 2:41, 46–47). Even in the midst of persecution, they continued to rejoice (Acts 5:41). It is hard for the world not to take notice of this.

We certainly need to consider the possibility that we are not as effective today in convincing our coworkers and communities of the value and validity of Christianity because we do not have any joy or hope visible in us. Although we may never convince the atheists of the world, we may win others. It certainly doesn't hurt to try.
